



## Fair 2025 Information and Dates

Hello FFA students and families,

I hope your summer is off to a good start. With fair right around the corner I wanted to send out an update with some important dates and other information.

- The schedule for the 2025 Hood River County Fair can be found <u>here.</u> Please note that all 4 H deadlines are the same for FFA.
- The June 21 Fairground clean up day was canceled. It has been combined with the barn set up day on Saturday, July 19 at 7:00am. This is mandatory for all students.
- Everything you need is noted in detail in the <u>fair schedule</u> but here is a summary of important dates:
  - June 30, registration due (Phelps needs a final list of the animals and classes you are showing.)
  - Wednesday July 9 small animal prefair
  - Saturday July 12, small animal prefair and large animal open scale
  - Monday, July 14, <u>mandatory FFA Meeting.</u> 5:30pm in HRVHS room A08.
     (Zoom option for those who are out of town.)
  - Saturday, July 19, <u>mandatory barn set up</u> and fairground clean up.
  - Sunday, July 20, 2pm-Monday evening is trailer/tent set up
  - Monday, July 21 8-4pm static exhibits registered in Wy'East gym. Barn decorating 5pm.
  - Tuesday, July 22, animal registration
  - Wednesday-Saturday animal shows
  - Friday, July 25, Auction. 4:00 buyers BBQ and registration, 5:30 Auction.
  - Sunday, July 27 clean up finished by 10am.
- Market animals\* Make sure that you have a handwritten thank you card and small gift for your auction buyer ready to give to them at the auction.

- AET will be a primary source of communication. Please make sure that your phone number, email, and parents phone number and email are up to date in your profile.

- All animal projects need to be logged in AET. A tutorial on how to complete your SAE plan can be found here. video1856705845.mp4 (only 1 student in the chapter has a completed plan. The rest of you need to complete your plans and get both parent and supervisor esignatures.)
- You need to have 9 journal entries per SAE project. You can record these retroactively if you have been keeping track on paper or in your phone notes. I recommend not waiting until the last minute to do this.
- AET Login Information:
  - Our chapter is OR0092
  - Your username and password should both be the CAPITAL first letter of your first name and your last name with a CAPITAL first letter and the rest of the name in lowercase. Example: Sophie Phelps=SPhelps
